## H.A.R.D. BOARD OF DIRECTORS' BI-MONTHLY MEETING *Actions and Calendar of Upcoming Events*

The Hayward Area Recreation and Park District (H.A.R.D.) conducted its Board of Directors' meeting on Monday, December 22, 2014. The following action was taken:

- Re-Appointed Kari McAllister, Justin King, and Jill Stavosky to serve on the Hayward Area Recreation and Park District's Citizens Advisory Committee, effective immediately, to two-year terms ending December 31, 2016.
- Elected three Board Officers as follows: President, Paul W. Hodges, Jr.; Vice President, Minane Jameson; and Secretary, Louis M. Andrade.
- Established meeting dates for Calendar Year 2015; with all meetings beginning at 7:00 p.m. unless otherwise posted.

- Appointed Vicente Zuniga to the position of Recreation Coordinator II in the Recreation Department at a salary of \$5,542 per month, \$66,504 annually, effective January 1, 2015.
- Authorized the General Manager to extend the agreement with Industrial Employers and Distributors Association to provide employment services to the District for an additional 3 years, through December 31, 2017 for a fee not to exceed \$25,000 in year one, \$25,750 in year two, and \$26,500 in year three.
