Dear Parents / Guardians of Sulphur Creek Campers,

Thank you for signing your child up for Wildlife Camp at Sulphur Creek Nature Center. Our camp staff is very excited about meeting your child and sharing with them a week of fun activities. Each day will bring the excitement of learning about life's circles and cycles. Your child will have an opportunity to meet animals, play games and make crafts. A daily snack will be provided (ingredients posted daily at check in).

Camp runs Monday through Friday from 9:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. You may drop your child off daily in the Discovery Center any time after 9:20 a.m. and pick them up in the Discovery Center anytime before 2:45 p.m. To ensure the safety of your child we will require that you or another authorized person (as indicated on your Wildlife Emergency/Safety form) sign your child in and out, daily at the Discovery Center desk. Please bring a photo ID when picking up your child.

To prepare for camp, please fill out the posted Emergency/Safety form and bring it with you on the first day of camp. Other forms to be signed on the first day will be a photo release (photos may be used for promotional material, including advertisements and website) and one for Wildlife Camp rules, which we will go over with your child. These forms are designed to ensure a fun, safe and rewarding experience for all at camp.

Campers are advised to **bring a lunch and a filled water bottle, wear sunscreen, and wear sturdy play clothes** (i.e. T-shirts, jeans, tennis shoes, NO OPEN TOED SHOES). Please send a sweatshirt or windbreaker with your child. Clothing labeled with your child's name will help ensure a safe return. Campers will receive a camp T-shirt on the first day of camp. For safety reasons, we encourage all campers to wear their camp T-shirt while attending Wildlife Camp.

On Friday at 1:45pm we would like to invite you to our theater for *The Week in Review*, a production created and performed by Sulphur Creek staff, residents, and campers!
