Actions and Calendar of Upcoming Events

Hayward, CA (August 14, 2014) – The Hayward Area Recreation and Park District (H.A.R.D.) conducted its Board of Directors' meeting on Monday, June 9, 2014. The following actions were taken at the regular bi-monthly meeting:

- Dr. Christina Chin-Newman was appointed to serve on the Hayward Area Recreation and Park District's Citizen's Advisory Committee, effective immediately with term ending on December 31, 2015. Dr. Christina Chin-Newman is a Castro Valley resident and an Assistant Professor of Human Development at California State University, East Bay.
