## **H.A.R.D. BOARD OF DIRECTORS' BI-MONTHLY MEETING** *Actions and Calendar of Upcoming Events*

Hayward, CA (Tuesday, May 12, 2015)

The Hayward Area Recreation and Park District (H.A.R.D.) conducted its Board of Directors' meeting on Monday, May 11, 2015. The following action was taken:

- Tabled motion for the proposed expansion of the Castro Valley Veterans Memorial.
- Approved Change Order No. 1 in the amount of \$13,885 for the HVAC Upgrades at San Felipe Community Park.
- Accepted Completion of Contract for the Restroom Replacement Site work at Mervin Morris Park.
- Authorized expenditure of funds not to exceed \$208,814.91 for the purchase of the restroom building for Stonebrae Field.
- Accepted the request for retirement from Mr. Gary Vannucci retirement effective April 30, 2015.
- Adopted a resolution establishing the Hayward Area Recreation and Park District's Fiscal Year 2015/2106 Appropriations Limit at \$27,956,356.
- Approved the Preliminary Budget for Fiscal Year 2015/2016 and scheduled a Public Hearing on Monday, July 27, 2015, prior to adoption of the Fiscal year 2015/2106 Budget.

The next meeting of the Board of Directors will be held on Tuesday, May 26, 2015 at 7:00 p.m., preceded by a Closed Work Session at 5:30 p.m. at the District Administration Office.
