## **H.A.R.D. BOARD OF DIRECTORS' BI-MONTHLY MEETING** *Actions and Calendar of Upcoming Events*

The Hayward Area Recreation and Park District (H.A.R.D.) conducted its Board of Directors' meeting on Monday, September 14, 2015. The following action was taken:

- Approved the Castro Valley Veteran's Memorial expansion. Staff directed to work with the Castro Valley VFW Post 9601 on a Memorandum of Understanding for the construction project.
- Authorized expenditure of funds in the amount of \$543,448 for the purchase of three (3) prefabricated buildings from Public Restroom Company for San Lorenzo Community Park.
- Approved request to Change Order No. 1 in the amount of \$650 for the Replacement of Tennis Courts at Mt. Eden Park.
- Accepted the completion of the contract for the resurfacing of the Tennis Courts at Mt. Eden Park in accordance with the plans and specifications.
- Adjourned the meeting in honor and memory of Recreation Leader V Simonette Mirnade's father, Mr. George S. Mirande; and local civic leader, Mr. Gilbert Zaballos, who both passed away on Wednesday, August 26, 2015.
