H.A.R.D. BOARD OF DIRECTORS' BI-MONTHLY MEETING *Actions and Calendar of Upcoming Events*

Hayward, CA (Tuesday, September 29, 2015)

The Hayward Area Recreation and Park District (H.A.R.D.) conducted its Board of Directors' meeting on Monday, September 28, 2015. The following action was taken:

- Awarded Monthly Volunteer Recognition Award for September 2015 to Ms. Angela Patch who works at the Matt Jimenez Community Center Summer camp program.
- Approved recommendation for Option B to be included as the Final Parking Plan, and make it a part of the Final Approved Master Plan for Fairmont Terrace Park.
- Approved additional recommendation and adoption of the Fairmont Terrace Park Initial Study/Mitigated Negative Declaration (IS/MND) and the Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Plan (MMRP).
- Approved Change Order No. 1 for the Renovation of Greenwood Park in the amount of \$4,169 for the work which includes the installation of a cage, upsize of the gate valves, and, additional trenching.
- Approved request to advertise for bids for the Multi-Purpose Room and Restroom Renovation of the Sorensdale Recreation Center.
- Authorized General Manager to sign the Lease Option Agreement with Alameda County to allow the County to conduct testing for hazardous material at the Boston Road property site in Hayward.
- Approved Change Order No. 1 for Phase 1 Construction of the San Lorenzo Community Park for additional work to expedite the drying of the Bay Mud material in the amount of \$144,104.45.
- Approved new job descriptions and title changes for SEIU, Local 1021: Maintenance and Construction Technician I, Maintenance and Construction Technician II, Custodian, Park Equipment Operator, Park Maintenance Worker, Clerk I, and Clerk II.
- Approved recommendation for James Calceta and Darin Lee to remain in their current position of Golf Coordinator I and receive a 5% footnote, effective October 1, 2015.
- Approved the recommendation to appointment Mike Baratta to serve on the Hayward Area Recreation and Park District's Citizens Advisory Committee, effective immediately, with term ending December 31, 2016.
