H.A.R.D. BOARD OF DIRECTORS' BI-MONTHLY MEETING *Actions and Calendar of Upcoming Events*

Hayward, CA (Tuesday, February 9, 2016)

The Hayward Area Recreation and Park District (H.A.R.D.) conducted its Board of Directors meeting on Monday, February 8, 2016. The following action was taken:

- Directed Staff to schedule a meeting with the Program, Policy, and Public Relations Committee for further review of the proposed installation of a Gold Star Families Memorial Monument within the District and to explore possible site locations as well as attain support of the City of Hayward by Resolution.
- Adopted the Resolution approving Change Order No. 2 for the Castro Valley Swim Center Renovation Project in the amount of \$4,113.
- Adopted the Resolution Supporting the Application of Alameda County for funds from the State's House-Related Parks Program for Renovations to Edendale Park.
- Adopted the Resolution Authorizing the General Manager to execute a Professional Services Agreement with Acorn Group for an amount not to exceed \$40,000 for Phase II of Delfino Wetlands Habitat Room renovation at Hayward Shoreline Interpretive Center.

The next meeting of the Board of Directors will be held on Monday, February 22, 2016 at 7:00 p.m., at the District Administration Office.
