Hayward, CA; April 22, 2020 - Hayward Area Recreation and Park District (H.A.R.D.) and the Alameda County Flood Control & Water Conservation District (ACFCD) invite the community to share their ideas on the San Lorenzo Creekway. The San Lorenzo Creekway will be a multi-use path for walking and biking, connecting communities in San Leandro, San Lorenzo, Ashland, Cherryland, Hayward and Castro Valley.
