Hayward Area Recreation and Park District Fall Recreation Program registration begins on August 26

Hayward, CA; August 24, 2020 – The Hayward Area Recreation and Park District (H.A.R.D.) announced the Fall Recreation Programs Guide is now available. Registration for residents begins on **Wednesday, August 26, 2020**.
